



FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT (FERPA)

Miami Regional University is committed to the protection of its students' rights. In accordance with the Public Law 93- 380, Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, 1002.22, Florida Statutes (2004), the University allows students to review their educational records, challenge records they believe are erroneous or incomplete, and to limit the release of such information. Records will not be released without written consent of the student. In the event a court subpoenas student records the University will release these records without obtaining student's written consent. The parents of a dependent student have the right to inspect the dependent's university records on behalf of their minor.
